### The Use of Adobe Connect and Webcam

## **Hardware Equipment:**

- 1. **Sound card** in you PC is needed.
- 2. A **headphone** connected to the sound card jack is needed. (Provided by the workshop)
- 3. A **microphone** connected to the sound card jack is needed. (Provided by the workshop)
- 4. An USB **web camera** with software is needed for the on-line meeting. (<u>Provided by the workshop</u>)

# **Logitech Webcam Software:**

- Go to <u>www.logitech.com</u>, choose Support, select Support + Downloads, and choose Webcam, then choose Webcam **C170 or C210** (depends which one is provided to you). Or, you can just directly select the latest software and driver from <a href="http://www.logitech.com/en-us/support/webcam-c170?crid=405&osid=14&bit=64">http://www.logitech.com/en-us/support/webcam-c210?crid=405&osid=14&osid=14</a>
- 2. In normal case: As soon as you plug in the webcam the computer will detect and lead to Logitech website for installing the software.
- 3. The Logitech webcam software must be installed prior logging in the Acrobat Connect server at ODU.

### Logging in:

- Use one of the following (depends on the region that you will be attending)

  - to copy the URL into Internet Explorer or other internet browser to run.
- 2. At the login page that gives you a choice of logging in with a user name and password or login as a guest. Click the **guest** button.
- 3. The next screen will ask for your name and you must type your full name.
- 4. If Connect prompt you with "Add-in", respond with Yes.
- 5. Connect will send us a message that you wish to enter the meeting room. When we accept it, your computer will open a new Internet Explorer page/the meeting room with several small windows.

# **Testing You Audio Functions**

- 1. After you successful logged in
- 2. Click the Meeting Menu
- 3. Select the **Audio setup wizard**.
- 4. Go through the instructions to test your headphone and microphone.

#### **Activating Audio & Video:**

In the upper center window, there is a camera, speaker, and microphone icon. Click on them to activate your camera and microphone, they should turn **GREEN** when activated.

## **Operation in the Video Conferencing:**

- 1. Once we establish audio communications we will explain how Connect works.
- 2. There are a lot of features that allow us do whatever the regular meeting needs.

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
